Entry Requirements

Commencement at UQ

Semester 1 (February), or Semester 2 (July) each year

Academic entry requirements

- Successfully completed bachelor degree in the same discipline (Event, Hospitality, Hotel and Tourism) with an average grade of at least 4.5 out of 7 (4 = pass) UQ standard;
- Successfully completed a minimum 1 year of study in International Master's Program of Tourism and Hospitality at NKUHT International College with a passing average grade or above


